You have several years of professional expertise as a physiotherapist and as a researcher in one of the fields of our profession. Knowledge of new technologies and/or sustainable development would be a plus. You must have proven teaching experience and either certified didactic training or a strong motivation to acquire this certification rapidly. Additionally, you should have an interest in innovative teaching methods.

Motivated by a scientific career in the context of a University of Applied Sciences, you have proven skills in writing funding applications and have obtained several large grants as the main applicant. You have confirmed skills in leading research teams and have a list of international and national scientific publications. You have in-depth and diversified knowledge in statistical analysis (mastery of software such as SPSS, R and / or Matlab, MAXQDA or NVivo), you have an excellent mastery of French and English, both spoken and written (level C1 or C2).
