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MAJOR SCIENTIFIC ACHIEVEMENTS

Research ‘Another Roadmap School: Intertwining HiStories of Arts Education’

Between 2016 and 2019, *microsillons* was part – as main applicants, researchers and members of the coordination team – of an international research project named Another Roadmap School: Intertwining HiStories of Arts Education, with the support of the Mercator Foundation, Pro Helvetia and the ZHdK. In that frame, the collective researches on the years Freire spent in Geneva in the 1970's. A first milestone of this research was a series of public events organized in the frame of the Bienal de São Paulo, articulated around the study of the World Council of Churches (where Freire worked) archives. The research led to a festival (Vienna, fall 2017), an international symposium in Zürich (Summer 2018), an exhibition in Butare (Rwanda) (Summer 2018) and concluded with a publication (Fall 2018).

Exhibition project ‘Utopia & The Everyday. Between art and pedagogies’

In 2009-10, *microsillons* curated an exhibition names ‘Utopia and the Everyday. Between art and pedagogy’ at Le Centre d’art contemporain Genève. The exhibition intended to look at the relationships between art and pedagogy. Three artists or collectives whose artistic practices involve teaching/pedagogical strategies were invited to Geneva to develop original projects in collaboration with local participants. The results of these collaborations were presented in the exhibition. In addition, a documentary and theoretical section, organized thematically, provided information on past projects, focusing on their educational dimensions. More than 5000 people visited the exhibition, which was discussed in several articles by *microsillons* and by peers. Freire is a key reference to many of the artists and gallery educators presented in the exhibition. Moreover, the title ‘Utopie et quotidieneté’ was borrowed to Moacir Gadotti’s book ‘L’éducation contre l’éducation’ (1979) which is prefaced by Freire.

PhD thesis

‘Blackboards were turned into tables ... Questionning “horizontality” in collaborative pedagogical art projects’

The research (University of The Arts London / Supervisors: David Cross and Neil Cummings, 2015), based on the practice of the collective *microsillons* questioned ‘horizontality’ in collaborative pedagogical art projects. The aim of the research was to explore the possibilities offered by ‘horizontal pedagogical exchanges’ and to question the very notion of ‘horizontality’. It interrogated the possibility to challenge, through artistic projects in educational contexts, the traditional master–pupils (or artist–participants, or gallery educator–public) relationship. Paulo Freire’s reflection about dialogical pedagogy serves as a starting point in this reflection.
