- a CV
- a letter of motivation
- a portfolio (PDF or weblink)
- the last transcript of records available

To participate in the one-year exchange program, start by applying for a single semester. You can ask for an extension during your first semester at HEAD.

SELECTION PROCESS AND ACCEPTANCE

A special focus on the portfolio quality will be given for the selection of the students. In your cover letter, kindly articulate your motivation for applying to the specific program. Language level is also taken into account. Notes of acceptance will be given in **June** (for the Fall semester) and **November** (for the Spring semester).

CREDITS SYSTEM

One semester at HEAD Genève is equivalent to 30 ECTS and we expect exchange students to complete a full semester.

ACCOMMODATION, HEALTH INSURANCE, VISA AND RESIDENCY PERMIT

HEAD Genève does not provide Campus accommodation. Students must find apartments or rooms by their own means. Since the housing market is very tight in Geneva, we advise them to look for an accommodation as soon as possible. Medical Health and third liability insurances are required. Students must get an insurance policy covering any health issue for the whole duration of their studies in Switzerland. Visa and Residency permit procedures depend on the nationality/residency country of the students.
