<p>SEMP AND INTERNATIONAL GRANTS</p>	<p><u>ERASMUS COUNTRY STUDENTS</u> <u>SWISS EUROPEAN MOBILITY PROGRAM – SEMP</u></p> <p>Switzerland is not associated to the Erasmus+ program anymore. An interim solution, the Swiss-European Mobility Program, provides grants for both incoming mobility as well as outgoing.</p> <p>Erasmus country students coming from DK, FI, IS, IE, LI, LU, NO, SE, UK partner schools, will receive CHF 1'900.- for their exchange semester at HEAD – Genève.</p> <p>Erasmus country students coming from AT, BE, BG, CY, CZ, DE, EE, EL, ES, FR, HR, HU, IT, LT, LV, MK, MT, NL, PL, PT, RO, SI, SK, TR partner schools, will receive CHF 2'200.- for their exchange semester at HEAD – Genève.</p>
