A colorful legwear evokes the

vibrant celebrations of her Latin-American community, resembling a lively field of flowers. The jacket, reminiscent of a bud hesitating to open, is crafted from a rigid fabric that recalls the landscapes of the Valais vineyards and the traditional attire of the peasants from her childhood village.

"Runa" embodies the duality of her cultures, balancing severity and festivity.
