This look features a long-sleeved sport polo neck sweater with scarf-knot cuffs, padded cycling shorts for comfort, a cap with a helmet visor, and durable leather mittens.

The first story, "Ferda," tells of an ant working diligently for her community and the planet. Ferda captivates a ladybug by adorning herself with fabric wings, evoking a vibrant parade akin to a bike race, with

polka-dot patterns, red accents, a heart yoke, and interchangeable antennae.

The second story follows "Krték," a mole exploring a forest and encountering signs of urban development, such as red and white striped poles and building site patterns. This narrative symbolizes travel and urban progression, mirroring the experiences Sacha encounters while cycling.
