#### **Cost of Living**

Cost of living	The currency in Switzerland is the Swiss franc or CHF, although many shops do accept Euros. The average cost of living in Switzerland is higher than it is in its neighbouring European countries. For basic expenses such as food, housing, and public transport, students will need about CHF 1,500 per month.
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#### Accomodation

Accomodation	HEAD – Genève does NOT offer any student accommodation. Students must find apartments or rooms on their own. Since the housing market is very tight in Geneva, we advise them to look for an accommodation as soon as possible.
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#### Insurance

Insurance	Medical Health and third party liability insurances are required. Students must get an insurance policy covering any health issue for the whole duration of their studies in Switzerland during their stay as exchange students. Students have to take care of appropriate health insurance by themselves.
