The application is online, through our MoveOn portal. Students will have to upload :

- a photocopy of your passport
- a CV
- a letter of motivation
- a portfolio (PDF or weblink)
- the last transcript of records available

Credits System

One semester at HEAD Genève is equivalent to 30 ECTS.

Accommodation, Health Insurance, Visa and Residency Permit

HEAD Genève does not provide Campus accommodation. Students must find apartments or rooms by their own means. Since the housing market is very tight in Geneva, we advise them to look for an accommodation as soon as possible

Medical Health and third liability insurances are required. Students must get an insurance policy covering any health issue for the whole duration of their studies in Switzerland.

Visa and Residency permit procedures depend on the nationality/residency country of the students.
