HEAD – Genève's Interior Architecture Department trains designers to meet the many contemporary challenges pertaining to urban densification, the emergence of eco-neighbourhoods, and the intermingling of populations. The various skills taught in the Interior Architecture programme include designing public and private spaces, working and living spaces, temporary constructions and furniture destined to last. An MA programme (2 years, 120 ECTS) will very shortly supplement the current BA programme (3 years, 180 ECTS).

The reflective and critical input of theory is essential in students' careers to strengthen their creative potential and technical skills with in-depth analyses and a capacity for anticipation and exploration.
