Part 2 – Brainstorming

Working in groups, we will try to propose answers some questions. Candidate questions include:

- Do we agree on the problem we are addressing?
- How do we finance cyber-security for SMOs?
- How can security providers collaborate more efficiently?
- How do we avoid cognitive overload by SMO managers?
- Are our current approaches really working? Why not?
- What should we do TODAY?

The (nice to have) objective: agreement on the problem and on steps that we can take now, collaboratively.
