Description du poste / Description of the position

The postdoctoral fellow will participate in a new 3 year Swiss National Science Foundation project : « Blockchain in audit and control professions: towards a new paradigm? » He or she will be in charge of the research focusing on the identification and application of audit rules in relation with blockchain supported business processes. This study will involve qualitative fieldwork mainly in Switzerland, and possibly Europe and include publishing results in scientific conferences and journals. He or she will work in close collaboration with a doctoral student in Information Systems at the Centre Universitaire d'Informatique, University of Geneva, focusing on the design and implementation of blockchain based prototypes. He or she will be supervised by Nathalie Brender (professor in management).
