IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT THE APPLICATION PROCEDURE

GENERAL ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

There is no **age limit** for entry into the Haute école de musique de Genève. However, the assessment of future development is an important criterion in the selection of students. If two candidates show equal qualities, preference is given to the younger one.

Applicants must hold a **general education diploma (maturité, high school diploma, baccalaureat)** or an equivalent diploma. Exceptionally, the admissions board can decide to forego this requirement if the candidate shows outstanding musical talent (cf. art. 7 du Règlement d'admission en Bachelor dans le domaine Musique et Arts de la scène HES-SO).

Candidates applying for the master programmes must hold a bachelor's degree in Music or an equivalent undergraduate degree in Music (HEM diploma, University-level diploma or licence).

Classes are given in French, so students need to have basic French skills, corresponding to the level B1 for the Bachelor program, and to the level A2 for the Master program (Cadre européen commun de référence pour les langues - CECR). Students admitted into the Haute école de musique de Genève who do not have the required level must take the French classes organized by the HEM - Genève.

Application procedure

The admission examinations are subdivided into one or two examinations, which are both disqualifying. All the examinations are listed in the table below according to the programme and the orientation. A detailed description of the content of the tests, as well as the imposed repertoires for the auditions, can be found on the website <http://www.hesge.ch/hem/admissions>.

The dates of the auditions can be found on our website. Before the date of the examination, candidates will receive a letter informing them of the time and place of their exam.

The results are sent by email after each examination. For programmes and orientations requiring two examinations, only those candidates who have successfully passed the first part of the examination will be required to pass the second part. The convocation to the 2nd admission test and the success of it do not constitute the definitive guarantee of a place of study at the HEM.

The results of all the admission examinations are reviewed by an examination board, which will make the final decision about the admission. Candidates who have been accepted by the admission board will receive a registration form, which they must return by the stipulated date. The results are sent by email after each examination. If two entrance examinations are successful, one of the two courses must be chosen definitively.

First instrumental or vocal audition

Candidates passing the first instrumental or vocal audition are asked to send the list of works for the audition, in accordance with the list of repertoires indicated on the Haute école de Musique de Genève website. Candidates are asked to send the list of works they will play to the accompanist. The designated accompanist is the only person entitled to accompany the candidates during the examination.

General musical education tests

The general musical education tests make up the second part of the examination for applicants into the bachelor programme. They take place in different phases during the same day: written exam – oral exam. A more detailed description of these tests can be found on our website <http://www.hesge.ch/hem/admissions>. This test is also compulsory for all candidates for a bachelor in the Early Music Department.

Results

In the days following the audition, candidates will receive an email informing them of the result of their exam, with the following assessments:

- *admis*: the candidate has successfully passed the test, and a place has been reserved for her or for him.
- *admis à la seconde épreuve* : the candidate is invited to pass the second examination (mandatory for all Bachelors, and for some Master orientations according to the list below).
- *admissible*: the candidate has the required level to enter the Haute école de musique de Genève, but there is no space available. The candidate is placed on a waiting list and can be accepted if a space is freed during the first semester and if he has passed all entrance examinations. At the end of the first semester, the “admissible” candidates are taken off the waiting list.
- *non admissible*: the candidate does not have the required level to enter the Haute école de musique de Genève.

Applications into other Hautes Ecoles de Musique of Western Switzerland

Candidates have the possibility to apply for several auditions in Western Switzerland, for the different study locations for the HEM and for the HEMU. A candidate who has been admitted into more than one Haute Ecole de Musique must choose the location where he or she wishes to study before May 31st.

Scholarships

We would like to draw the attention of candidates to the fact that most financial support organizations (scholarships) don't intervene before the second year of studies. It is therefore recommended to arrive in Switzerland with sufficient means of subsistence.
